Why are we here and what is our protest about?

The protest is organized by the coalition #NoBärgida, supported by a variety of organizations and groups. A colorful cross-section of the population is taking part in our protest, i.e. residents, antifascists, and democratic parties. We are the counter-protest to Bärgida, and together we take a stand against racism and social exclusion. A solidary and equal co-existence can only be realized when there is no discrimination against any human beings - regardless of their origin, religion, lifestyle or social status. That's what we stand up for since weeks in the Berlin district of Moabit and since months in Berlin's entire Central district (Mitte).

What is Bärgida?

Bärgida is the Berlin-offshoot of PEGIDA (Patriotic Europeans against the Islamization of the Occident). ["Bär" stands for "Bärlin", a little joke on the the bear as Berlin' flagshipl animal.] Since 5th of January 2015 the movement is rallying on the streets of Berlin. The organizer, Karl Schmitt, who also founded the association BärGiDa-PeGiDa-Berlin e.V., is a former activist of the party "Die Freiheit" and other right-wing associations. Key subject of the Bärgida movement is the alleged foreign domination, so-called asylum abuse, conspiracy theories, and "Islamization".

Who's taking part in the Bärgida protest?

It is not really a matter of "worried citizens". Bärgida is rallying together with the NPD (National "Democratic" Party Germany), the AfD (Alternative for Germany), "Identitäre Bewegung" (Identitarian Movement) and neo-Nazis. Small political parties such as "pro Deutschland" and "Die Freiheit" are taking part in the rallies as well. Hooligans are joining the protest alongside the "Alliance of German Hools – B.d.H" and "Hooligans against Salafists – HoGeSa". The "German Defence League" is attending the march too.
